Dear Mr. van Lierde,

It is my pleasure to inform you that, at the last meeting of the IOC Executive Board, which took place in Atlanta in December 1994, the International Olympic Committee granted recognition to the **Fédération Internationale du Sport pour Tous (F.I.S.p.T.)**, as a *Recognized Organisation*.

This decision has still to be ratified by the IOC Session to be held in Budapest next June.

This recognition is given **provisionally for a two-year period** before becoming definitive. After this period, the F.I.S.p.T. will have to make a new request to the Executive Board in order to obtain final IOC recognition as a *Recognized Organisation*.

May I take this opportunity to officially welcome you as part of the Olympic Movement.
